2008 -WYVERN SHORE FESTIVAL Beesands & Slapton, 11th Jan 2009. General Information

Entrance Fee: £7.00 per an entrant Senior £6.00 Junior.

Guernsey Heat: All Senior competitors taking part in the Festival, will be automatically entered into the Guernsey Open Competition 2009. A place in the final will be awarded to the overall winner, along with the first prize. Anglers under 18 cannot be entered for the Guernsey Qualifier

Pool: There will be an optional pool of £1.00 that will be distributed to the best single specimen as follows: 50% to the best specimen, 30%, 2nd best specimen and 20 % 3rd best specimen.

Fishing Times: Sign – On from 12:00 pm at Beesands, fishing from 2:00pm to 7:.00pm at Beesands and Slapton Sands as indicated on the beach by the end markers. Slapton Sands: Memorial South (toilets) to Torcross slipway marker flags. Beesands as indicated by marker flags.

NOTE: END MARKER FLAGS WILL BE DISPLAYED AT 11:00AM ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION.

Weigh In: At Beesands Cricket Inn, 7.00pm to 8.00pm.

NO BAGS ACCEPTED AFTER 8.00 PM.

Awards: The Wyvern Division Trophies will be presented along with good quality prizes.

Teams: To consist of a maximum of 4 anglers. A competitor may only represent one team and must nominate that team when signing on. Teams can consist of less than 4 anglers, but only the best fish from each angler will count. Aggregate specimen rules, with the best specimen from each team angler counting (As judged against area C specimen weights). The winning team who has the highest total of specimen points will be awarded the Wyvern Division Open Shore Championships Team Shield.

ONE ANGLER CAN ONLY TAKE ONE PRIZE WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE TEAM PRIZE.

Competition Rules

- 1: All competitors to sign at Beesands HQ which will be clearly Marked.
- 2: NFSA Festival and competition rules will apply. Minimum sizes will be observed, and undersize fish should not be brought to the scales. One rod with a maximum of 3 hooks and no feathering.
- 3: Awards are for the highest percentage of 2 different species or single specimen.

 A competitor may only bring 1 fish of the same species to the scales i.e. 1 Dab, 1 Mackerel, 1 Garfish. MINI SPECIES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.
- *4: All competitors will be considered as a senior for this event.*
- 5: All beach limits will be marked , all sections will be stewarded and all fish MUST be registered with a steward upon capture.
- *The competition will be started and ended on the direction of the stewards.*
- 7: Competitors must attach their entry form/bag ticket to their provided bags before handing in their catches for weighing at the championship headquarters from 7 to 8:00pm. Scales close 8:00 pm. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS IS CLEARLY PRINTED ON THE ENTRY FORM.
- 8: No more than one of the same species can be brought to the scales.
- 9: All fish may be collected at the conclusion of the weigh in. Any fish not collected will be disposed of by the committee.
- 10: Any objections MUST be lodged with the committee within 15 minutes of the result being announced.
- 11: On any matters arising from these championships, the decision of the organising committee will be deemed as final.
- 12: All unwanted fish must be left at the weigh in the fish box provided.
- 13: All fish will be weighed against NFSA area C specimen weights and minimum sizes listed overleaf.
